

FOURTH DAY: VIKING ISLANDS

Visit by all the South part of the islands. We decide to begin by the end and to be raising slowly. We arrive at Å, plenty of gulls, a furnace of firewood, difficult to see here. It is the last town if we do not want to jump rather more far to another island. We raise towards **Hamnøy** and, later, we make another stop in **Reigne**. Precious views with the lake and the mountains. The following station is **Ramberg** with white sand beaches. We find an elevated place to make photos of the panoramic view. The umbrella that we bought in Oslo protects us very much. The museum causes a good impression to us. It recreates the atmosphere of the time. We can imagine the king seated in its throne and all around the brawny men of the north.
