Kapellbrücke or Chapel Bridge, wooden bridge 200m long of XIV century with an octagonal tower, **Wasserturm or Water Tower**, which served as a defense, prison and keep the treasure of the city.

Jesuit Church, along the entire river are several monuments looming presence. The Jesuitenkirche of St. Francis Xavier is the seventeenth century.
